GOAL

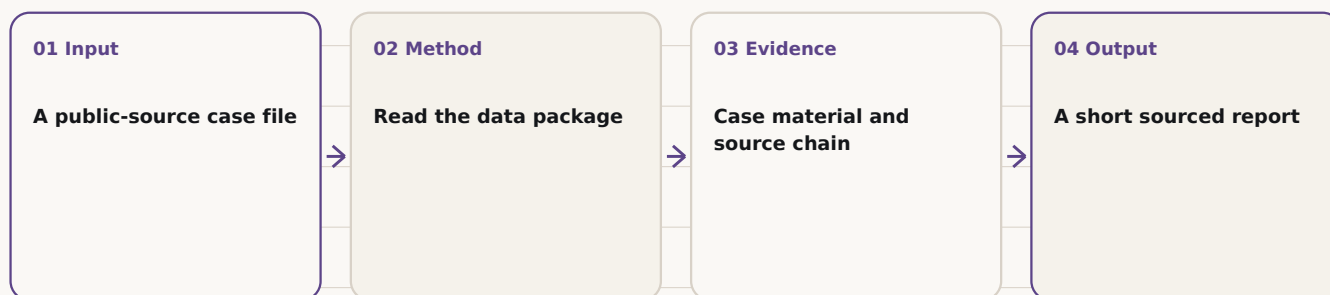
Provides sourced research and reporting practice with files derived from public events.

WHO IS IT FOR?

For people who want to practise reporting from public-source case files while keeping source, claim, and uncertainty separate.

TECHNICAL FLOW

Input, method, evidence, and output

HOW DOES IT WORK?

Step 1

Choose a file

Choose a case file such as visual geolocation, incident analysis, or source assessment.

Step 2

Read the data package

Review the public-source material, context notes, and task question together.

Step 3

Separate the claim

Record what the source directly shows, the interpretation, and the missing evidence separately.

Step 4

Use the hints

The hint section points to a useful check without giving the result away.

Step 5

Compare with the answer key

Compare your evidence chain and wording with the answer key, and note the reason for any difference.

Step 6

Write a short report

Write sources, findings, uncertainty, and the next safe check in short, calm language.

LIMITS

The files are for training and method practice. They do not amplify sensitive personal data, and one source or image is not treated as a final result.
