PURPOSE OF THE SITE

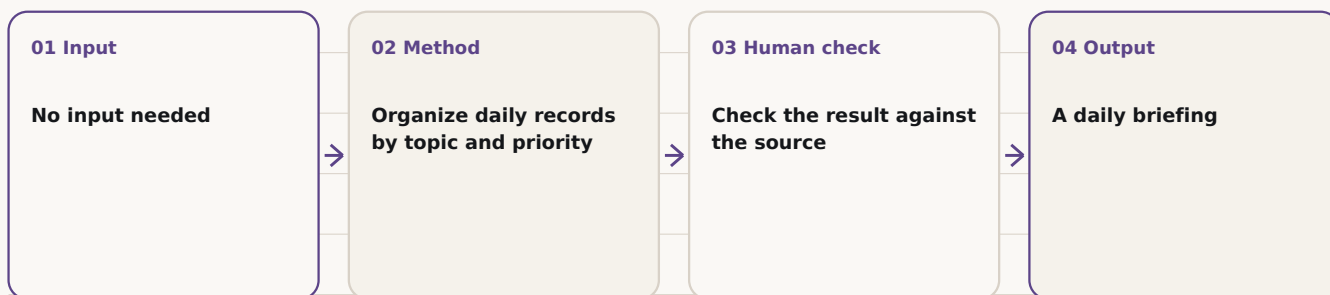
This site exists to turn one question into a safe, repeatable research process. A tool result is not a verdict; the source and the human check stay visible.

I built this to summarize what changed, who reported it, and what remains uncertain instead of copying the day's threat feed.

SMALL ARCHITECTURE

Four parts from input to a record you can keep



Daily briefing

USE IT STEP BY STEP

Step 1

Prepare the material

Start with: No input needed

Step 2

Organize daily records by topic and priority

Presents the day's threat records as a short briefing.

Step 3

Check the result against the source

Open the original source and publication time before using a briefing item for a decision. Record any conditions omitted by the summary.

Step 4

Download and keep the record

Keep this at the end: A daily briefing

HONEST BOUNDARY

The briefing is a starting point. It is not a complete threat picture, organization-specific risk calculation, or verified intelligence judgement.
